RATINGS: Must have current PHRF valid certificate or provisional rating issued by PHRF of the Chesapeake, except for the Cruising Class. PHRF Equipment Category 5P applies. Crew sailing boats without lifelines must wear life jackets. Crew limitations for PHRF will not apply.

STARTING LINE: Between orange flag on Committee Boat and CCV mark "H"(Harbor).

FINISH LINE: Between orange flag on Committee Boat and the nearby Mark designated by the posted course, unless the course has been shortened.

COURSES: See CCV General Sailing Instructions.

RECALLS: Will be in accordance with RRS 29.1 and RRS 29.2

CRUISING CLASS: A non-spinnaker class open to all non-measured yachts. Courtesy ratings will be assigned by the race committee and shall not be subject to challenge.

PROTESTS: Protests will be heard at HYC at 1900 on Monday following each race. If the protester, protestee, and protest committee agree, the hearing may take place at an earlier mutually acceptable time.

SCORING: RRS Appendix A, Low Point System applies, except there will be no throw-out unless all five (5) scheduled races are completed, and except that RRS A4.2 is replaced by the following:
"A boat that came to the starting area but did not start, did not finish, retired after finishing, or was disqualified shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats that came to the starting area. A boat that did not come to the starting area shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats entered in one or more races of the series."

AWARDS: Daily awards will be made following each race. Series awards per the CCV Sailing Instructions will be presented at the Hampton Yacht Club Annual Awards Night on December 8th.

NOTE: Free dockage (10/31/09-12/13/09) may be available on a first come, first served basis for participating boats from outside the Hampton Roads area only. Priority will be given to those from the farthest away.
