**Directions to HYC:** From I-64, take exit #267. Follow signs to Downtown Hampton. Cross the bridge over Hampton River. Just past the Air & Space Museum (on your left), turn left onto Bridge Street. Go about ½ mile, and Hampton Yacht Club is on your left behind the large black cannon.

**Note:** Please follow parking guidelines provided by regatta organizers; parking rules will be enforced.

Spectator boats are strongly encouraged, given limited shore-viewing options. There is no on-site ramp available for launching spectator boats, but call Hampton Yacht Club (757-722-0711) for local alternatives. **Directions to Sunset Creek public boat launch:** from the Yacht Club, stay straight on Victoria. Turn left at the first traffic light on to Kecoughtan. Turn left at the next traffic light on to Ivy Home Road. Follow the signs to the public boat launch.
