



NOTICE OF RACE



HAMPTON ONE-DESIGN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

HAMPTON YACHT CLUB, HAMPTON, VA
August 14 -16, 2009

WHERE: *Registration and launch facilities at Hampton Yacht Club, 4707 Victoria Blvd., Hampton, VA 23669. Races will be sailed in the vicinity of the Hampton Flats.*

WHEN: *Registration for this regatta will be from 1000-1150 on Friday, August 14. A skipper's meeting will be held at noon on that day. Six races are scheduled as follows:*

4	Saturday, Aug. 15	Immediately after Race 3
5	Saturday, Aug. 15	Immediately after Race 4
6	Sunday, Aug. 16	1030 -- Warning Signal
Make-up	Sunday, Aug. 16	Immediately after Race 6, if required

No races will be started after 1500, Sunday, August 16. Four races must be completed to constitute a series. There will be a throw-out if all six races are completed. Purpose of Heritage Race is to provide racing and photo opportunities for all. Regatta participants are strongly encouraged to participate.

RULES: *The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), together with the prescriptions of US Sailing, the Hampton One Design class rules and the Sailing Instructions issued at registration.*

ELIGIBILITY: *All Hampton One Design owners who have paid their class dues and participated in three CBYRA-sanctioned HOD regattas since the 2008 Nationals are eligible. The Hampton One Design National Executive Committee will make final decisions on eligibility. Heritage Race is open to all interested sailors; there are no eligibility requirements. The Heritage Race will only occur if four or more Heritage fleet boats register.*

EQUIPMENT: *Competitors are reminded that the class rules require each boat to carry a paddle, an anchor, 50 feet of 1/4-inch anchor line, and life jackets for the skipper and crew. This equipment must be verified by class measurers between 1000 and 1150 Friday morning. In accordance with the class rules, competitors must designate a maximum of two sets of measured sails to be used during the regatta at the equipment check Friday morning.*

ENTRY FEE: *Competitors are strongly encouraged to pre-register; registration materials and instructions available at www.shoren.net/hamptonone. The early registration fee is \$225 USSA member or \$250 non USSA member, which includes 3 days of racing, dinner on Friday and Saturday nights for skipper and crew, and lunch on Sunday for skipper and crew. An additional \$25 will be charged if registration is not paid by August 1st. Pre-registered competitors must check in at the registration table on Friday morning between 1000 and 1150 to pick up Sailing Instructions, equipment forms, and meal tickets. Friday lunches, bag lunches, and buffet breakfasts will be available for purchase.*
