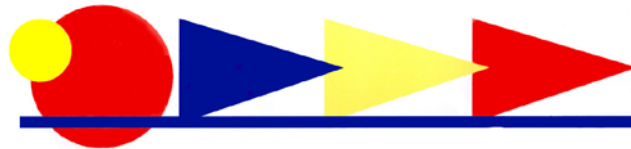

- Host Clubs:** Hampton Yacht Club, Cruising Club of Virginia, and Old Point Comfort Yacht Club, are the organizing authorities for this regatta.

- Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing, 2009-2012*, except as modified by the regatta Sailing Instructions.
- Entry Due:** **Monday, May 24, 2010 (Early Bird Entry deadline - April 17, 2010)**
- Entry Fee:** \$140 *EARLY BIRD ENTRIES*, \$150 USSA members, \$155 non-USSA members
- Checks payable to: SBRW (Southern Bay Race Week)
EARLY BIRD ENTRIES - Entries received by April 17, 2010, receive special entry fee of \$140 and will receive 10 free regatta beverage tickets.
LATE FEE: Entries received after May 24th must include \$50 late fee.

- Classes:** Classes expected to compete include PHRF A, B, C, NS-2 (double headsail) and NS-1 (single headsail) classes, plus a special Cruising class. PHRF fleets may be further subdivided. One Design classes, monohull over 20 feet LOA, with at least five registered boats are encouraged and will be offered a separate start. Cruising Class boats (non-sanctioned, single headsail only) will receive a courtesy rating which may not be appealed. All PHRF boats must have a current valid PHRF rating certificate and must meet current category 4P of the PHRF Equipment and Accommodation Standards.
- Races:** Multiple races will be attempted each day beginning at 10:00AM. Drop mark courses will be located in the Chesapeake Bay off Ocean View. The Low Point Scoring System will be used. There will be no throw-outs.
- Skippers' Meeting:** **Mandatory registration and Skippers' Meeting on Thursday, June 3, 2010, at 7:00PM under the tent adjacent to Hampton Yacht Club. Final fleet splits will be announced at this time.**
- Awards-Social:** Daily awards and a Boat of the Day award for each course will be given at the post-race party under the tent. Overall series awards plus the Black Seal Trophy (Boat of the Week) will be presented following racing Sunday. Social activities including food and music will be under the tent each day. Opening night social (Thursday, June 3, 2010) under the tent from 6:00PM until 9:00PM
