2024 FROSTBITE SERIES

October 27, November 3, 10, 17, 2024

FORMAT: The series will consist of four races with a throw-out if all four races are completed and scored.

ENTRY DUE DATE/TIME: By 1200 hours on the day before the race.

ENTRY FEE: **SERIES:** \$85 or \$80 for CBYRA Members **PER RACE:** \$40 or \$35 for CBYRA Members.

CLASSES AND RATINGS: All PHRF boats must have a current, valid PHRF certificate. All boats, must meet PHRF of the Chesapeake Category Near Shore Safety and Equipment Requirements. Crew sailing boats without lifelines must wear life jackets. PHRF Crew limitations will not apply.

COURSES: As per CCV General Sailing Instructions.

STARTING SYSTEM: RRS 26.

	PHRF B/C	(B/C will start, race, and be scored together)	
	PHRF N	(Double-Headsails allowed)	
	CRUISING	(Single headsail, no spinnakers)	

STARTING LINE: Between the staff displaying an orange flag on the RC Signal Boat and CCV Harbor Mark "H" (R N "20") off Hampton Flats.

FINISH LINE: Between the staff displaying a blue flag on the RC Finish Boat and the nearby mark designated by the posted course, unless the course has been shortened.

TIME LIMIT: Any boat not finished within 3 ½ hours of its fleet's start will be scored DNF.

PROTESTS: Protests will be heard at HYC at 1900 on Monday, unless heard earlier by mutual agreement.

SCORING: RRS Appendix A, Low Point System applies except:

- There will be one throw-out if all four races are completed and scored
- Series ties shall be broken by applying the RRS A5.3:

"A boat that came to the starting area but did not start, did not finish, retired after finishing, or was disqualified shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats that came to the starting area.

A boat that did not come to the starting area shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats entered in the series."

AWARDS: Daily awards will be presented in the HYC lounge following each race. Series awards will be presented at the Hampton Yacht Club Annual Awards Night December 3.

This series counts toward the HYC CUP Championship.
