41 HYC boats competed for this year's HYC Big Boat Championship, the HYC CUP. And what a difficult year it was...seeing five of the nine HYC Cup races severely impacted by weather, with three cancelled all together. However, in HYC's finest tradition, everyone carried on smartly and, when the smoke cleared, Ben Cuker's Callinectes emerged as the clear cut winner of the CUP, beating Andy Armstrong's, Virginia H, by a comfortable five (5) points and John Blais', Stardancer, by seven (7).

It was Callinectes' second HYC CUP victory, having won the inaugural championship in 2016.

Andy Armstrong emerged as the "Iron Man", being the only boat to compete in every race.
